With flu season in full swing, it is important that we work together to keep our children healthy. Viruses spread easily among children in schools, and families with school-age children have more infections than others, with an average of one-third of these family members infected each year. By keeping our children flu-free, we benefit the community as a whole. You can help prevent the spread of the flu or help your child get better if he/she does get sick by following a few simple steps:




Remind your child to cover his/her nose and mouth with a tissue when sneezing or coughing and dispose of the tissue immediately or cough into his/her sleeve

- · Have your child wash his/her hands frequently with soap and warm water for at least 20 seconds
- \cdot Disinfect frequently-touched surfaces and shared items at least once a day
- \cdot Ensure that bathrooms are stocked with soap, hand towels, and tissues
- \cdot Teach your child not to touch his/her mouth, nose, and eyes
- · If your child is sick and has a fever, keep him/her at home until fever free for 24 hours without fever-reducing medications like Tylenol or Ibuprofen (Motrin) to prevent the spread of illness.

Common symptoms of flu include high fever, severe headache, muscle and body aches, exhaustion, and dry cough. Additionally, children often exhibit other flu symptoms that are rare in adults, such as nausea, vomiting, and diarrhea.
